## Why does Epsilon State offer this Scholarship program?

The scholarship program achieves several of the Society's Seven Purposes:



Purpose Three: to advance the professional interest and position of women in education.

Purpose Six: to stimulate the personal and professional growth of members and encourage their participation in appropriate programs of action.

These are the maximum possible funds awarded for the eleven state scholarships each year.

- \$2500** - Doctoral study
- \$1000** – Postdoctoral study
- \$2400** - Two semesters of full-time study
- \$2000** - Travel / Study stipend
- \$1200** – One semester of full-time study
- \$1000** – Full-time summer session (5+ hrs)
- \$ 500** - Part-time summer session in (1-4 hrs)
- \$ 500** – One semester of part time study

## Minimum requirements to apply:

1. Members must be in good standing of a Louisiana chapter and have been a **member for three years** before the first semester in which the scholarship is being awarded.\*
2. Must be planning to do graduate work in an approved institution of higher learning which offers a graduate degree in the field in which the applicant plans to study.
3. Must meet reasonable standards as far as general health, professional services, and community services.
4. Importance is attached to contributions of the applicant to Delta Kappa Gamma.
5. Criteria for the May A. Allen Study/Travel Scholarships are available online at Tulane University: <http://sopa.tulane.edu/content/may-allendelta-kappa-gamma-scholarships>. You must apply for admission to the School of Continuing Studies online.
6. State Founders Scholarship applicant shall be enrolled in a doctoral program or in post-doctoral study at an approved institution, have been a member of a Louisiana chapter a minimum of 5 years, and have served her chapter, district or state in an outstanding manner.

\*Applicants can apply for the Praxis reimbursement in their first year of membership.
